General 4-H, FFA Agriculture Division Rules:

- 1.) Refer to:
 - a. General Rules,
 - b. Open Agriculture Rules.
 - c. Health Requirements
- 2.) No entry fees are charged.
- 3.) All exhibitors must have not had their 19th birthday before Jan 1st of the current year.
- 4.) It is up to the discretion of each individual department superintendent to stop accepting entries when space becomes limited.
- 5.) All animals exhibited must be fitted and shown by the exhibitor, except classes in which the exhibitor has more than one (1) exhibit. Additional exhibits must be shown by another 4-H, FFA or Youth exhibitor.
- 6.) All animals must be owned by the exhibitor and all animals entered in breeding classes must be registered in exhibitor's name with registration papers from breed association available to Fair officials upon request. Animals with multiple owners on registration papers may be exhibited in the Junior Show as long as all owners are identified and shown on registration papers and entry forms.
- 7.) Showing and fitting ages will be based on age as of September 30 of the current year.
- 8.) Premium classes for showing and fitting will be restricted to youth, 4-H, and FFA members between the ages of 9 and 19.
- 9.) A novice showing and fitting class will be added if there are three or more eligible exhibitors.
- 10.) A pee wee showing and fitting class with no monetary award will be open to youth under 9 in dairy goats.
- 11.) To be eligible for all prizes and awards, Youth, 4-H, and FFA must take full responsibility for the care of their animals for the duration of their stay at the Fair.
